Lesser known facts about Tricolour/India

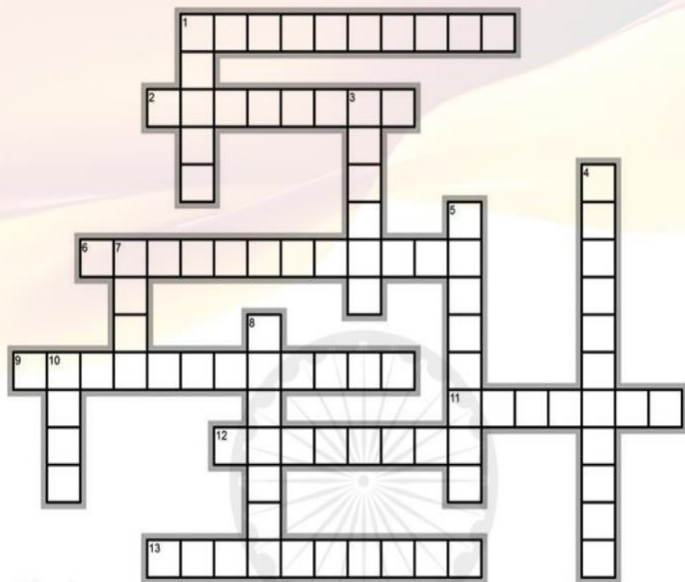
- ❖ India is the world's largest, oldest, continuous civilization and also the world's largest democracy!
